PUT ON GOD'S ARMOR

In Ephesians 6:10-18, God says that we are engaged in a war with our enemy, the devil. This war cannot be seen with our eyes, nor can we fight it with our fists. To fight, God has given us a very special armor.

The Armor of God protects us and makes us victorious in this invisible war. This armor is like the armor which superheroes wear to protect themselves from harm. However, ours is much **stronger** and more **powerful** and it protects our spirits! Each time we do what is right, we are wearing God's Armor.

Ephesians 6:11 "Put on the full Armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes*."

As we learn about the Armor of God, we must remember:

- 🛡️ We must wear the full Armor of God **at all times**.
- 🛡️ Our Armor works best when we **wear all the parts together**.
- 🛡️ When we **please God, we wear the Full Armor of God**, for example, worshiping, obeying our parents and praying.







A turtle's shell protect it from predators.




An armadillo is covered in armor! Its name in Spanish means "little armored one".




PARENTS' TIPS
